

Dr. Mark Drozdowski serves as executive in residence for the graduate programs in nonprofit management and philanthropy and higher education administration. To this role, Dr. Drozdowski brings nearly 20 years of experience in the higher education advancement field. He is an accomplished writer, editor, published author, and columnist with a strong fundraising and communications knowledge and skills base. He teaches MHE 600: Introduction to Higher Education Administration among other courses.

Currently, Dr. Drozdowski is the Executive Director for the Fitchburg State College Foundation where he is responsible for the development, alumni relations, and development communications operations. With overall responsibilities for the completion of a \$15 million capital campaign, he also monitors the investment activities of the \$10 million foundation portfolio.

Since 2001, Dr. Drozdowski has authored the highly popular column in The Chronicle of Higher Education, “The Fund Raiser”, a monthly feature on careers in university development and advancement.

While in this role, Dr. Drozdowski was twice awarded the Holland Award for outstanding promotional copywriting.

Dr. Drozdowski received the Doctorate in Higher Education along with the Masters of Education in Administration, Planning, and Social Policy from Harvard University. He earned a Bachelor of Arts degree with honors in American History from the University of Pennsylvania.
